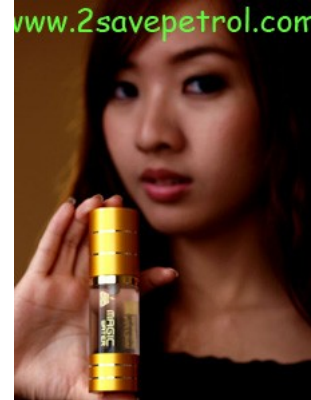




BACKGROUND INFORMATION ABOUT MAGIC WATER products

ENVIROMENTAL IMPLICATONS

REJUVENATE, NOT DISCARD

Malaysians consume three million automobile batteries each year and each battery often has a life span of between 15 to 24 months. These batteries contribute to over 12 million kilograms of lead pollution per year. Lead is a serious contaminant which can cause neurological damage, renal disease, cardiovascular ailments and even reproductive problems.

With the use of MAGIC WATER old automobile batteries can be rejuvenated giving them lengthened service life. MAGIC WATER rejuvenates batteries by desulfating the lead sulphate ($PbSO_4$) which coats the plates making it difficult for it to conduct electricity.

For new batteries treated with MAGIC WATER, they can be made to last up to five times their typical service length because MAGIC WATER reduces the sulfation process.

Both methods not only increase battery life but likewise reduce vehicle operational costs while at the same time saving the environment.

SAVING FUEL

MAGIC WATER can also save fuel. It does this as a 'side effect' of the desulfation process. When a battery is being recharged, the car engine provides the energy needed to recharge the battery. This in turn burns fuel. When a battery has been treated with MAGIC WATER, it conducts electricity more easily and hence less



energy is required to recharge it, this in turn helps save fuel by putting less strain on the engine.
